In Centola there's a medieval castle on the hill of the village, it's the San Sergio castle. It dates back to the **14th century** and it's made of stone. Today the castle is a B&B.







In the middle of the village there's the main church, its name is Saint Nicola di Mira. It dates back to **1617**. In **2014** it was rebuilt because it was ruined by an earthquake.







In the suburb of the village there is an area called Serra. There's a little church there; it belongs to the Lupo's family. It was built in **1869**. It's name is Padre Eterno. The bell tower is in the middle of the village, in the historic part. It dates back to the **1880-1890**. Now it's a tourist attraction.
